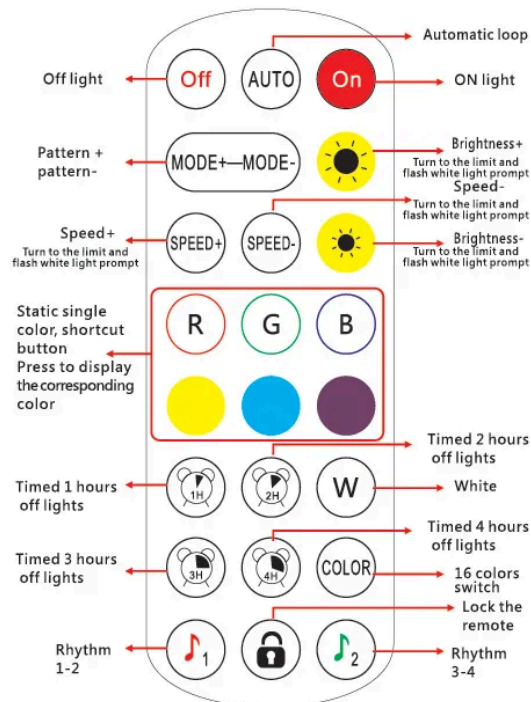
1. Setting Temperature

Use the Plus and Minus symbols on the Wine Cooler to set the desired temperature. The number displayed will revert to the current temperature of the wine cooler and will gradually shift to the desired temperature once that has been reached.



2. Using the Remote Control

LED2021 -24KEY



Rhythm 1-2: Single click to switch to 1-2 rhythm mode
 Rhythm 3-4: Click to cycle through the 3-4 rhythm mode
 Remote control lock: After pressing, the remote control is locked, pressing the switch is available, other keys are invalid. After pressing once, the unlock button can be used. After the remote control is locked, press the switch to unlock the remote control.



3. Maintenance

To keep your thermoelectric wine cooler running smoothly and efficiently, here are some suggested maintenance tips:

- 1. Keep it Clean:** Regularly clean the exterior and interior of the cooler. For the interior, use a soft cloth and a mild detergent. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the surfaces or leave harmful residues.
- 2. Check and Clean the Fans:** The fans in a thermoelectric cooler are crucial for its operation, as they dissipate heat from the cooling system.
