## Safety Advice

- Ensure you have read and fully understood the instruction manual and safety advice before using this product.
- Always inspect the carpet tiles before installation to check for defects, warping, damage, or contamination that may affect performance, appearance, or safety.
- Only install carpet tiles on clean, dry, smooth, and structurally sound subfloors; do not install over surfaces with moisture problems, unevenness, or loose debris.
- Ensure the subfloor is completely dry before installation; excess moisture can cause adhesive failure, mould growth, and product degradation.
- Use only adhesives, tackifiers, or fixing methods recommended by the tile manufacturer to ensure proper bonding and compatibility with the tile backing.
- Follow all manufacturer instructions and local safety regulations regarding the use and ventilation of adhesives; some products may emit fumes during application and curing.
- When using adhesives or tackifiers, wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including gloves and a mask where required by the product safety data sheet.
- Ensure adequate ventilation during and after installation to allow for proper adhesive curing and to prevent accumulation of potentially harmful fumes.
- Cut carpet tiles using a sharp utility knife and a straight edge on a stable surface; always cut away from your body and keep hands clear of the blade.
- Dispose of offcuts, backing, and packaging materials promptly to keep the work area free from trip hazards or obstruction.
- Install carpet tiles with tight seams and no raised edges to prevent trip hazards and ensure a smooth, even surface.
- If tiles are loose-laid or partially fixed, ensure all tiles are securely in place and cannot shift under foot traffic.
- Do not install carpet tiles near open flames, heaters, or high heat sources unless they are specifically rated for fire resistance in accordance with local building regulations.
- Regularly inspect installed tiles for signs of wear, loosening, lifting edges, or damage, especially in high-traffic areas, and replace or refix any affected tiles immediately.
- Do not expose carpet tiles to heavy rolling loads or dragging furniture across the surface unless the product is rated for such use, as this can cause delamination or shifting.
- Use protective pads or castor cups under furniture legs to prevent indentations, wear, or tile movement over time.
- Clean spills promptly and follow manufacturer-recommended cleaning procedures to avoid staining, mould growth, or degradation of adhesive bonds.



- Do not soak the carpet tiles during cleaning; excessive moisture can damage backing material and lead to dislodging or deterioration.
- If carpet tiles become saturated with water due to flooding or leaks, remove and dry thoroughly before reinstalling, or replace if material integrity is compromised.
- Always ensure replacement tiles match the original product specifications to maintain safety, stability, and fire performance ratings.
- Keep the installation area clear of unauthorised personnel, children, and pets during installation to prevent injury or disruption.
- Ensure all tools used for installation are stored safely when not in use and handled in accordance with general tool safety guidelines.

## 1. Maintenance Advice

- Vacuum carpet tiles regularly using a vacuum cleaner with appropriate suction and brush settings to remove dust, dirt, and debris that can cause wear and discolouration over time.
- Perform spot cleaning immediately after spills using a clean, dry cloth to blot (not rub) the affected area and prevent staining or moisture absorption into the backing.
- Use pH-neutral carpet cleaners; avoid harsh chemicals, bleach, or solvent-based cleaners that can damage fibres or adhesive.
- Test any new cleaning product on an inconspicuous area before full use to ensure it does not discolour or damage the tile surface.
- For deeper cleaning, use hot water extraction (steam cleaning) or low-moisture encapsulation methods where recommended by the tile manufacturer, ensuring the tiles are not over-wetted.
- Ensure carpet tiles dry fully after any cleaning process to prevent mould, mildew, or loosening of adhesive bonds; use fans or ventilation to speed up drying if needed.
- Rotate carpet tiles in high-traffic areas periodically (where possible) to promote even wear and extend the lifespan of the installation.
- Inspect carpet tiles regularly for signs of fraying, lifting, shifting, or edge curling, and address any issues promptly to prevent trip hazards or further damage.
- Replace damaged or heavily worn tiles with matching replacements from the original batch where available to maintain consistent appearance and performance.
- Avoid dragging heavy furniture or sharp objects across the surface of the carpet tiles; use protective sliders or lift items fully to prevent damage or shifting.
- Use entrance mats at all exterior doors to reduce dirt, moisture, and grit being tracked onto carpeted areas, which can accelerate wear and staining.
- Maintain indoor humidity levels within the range recommended by the manufacturer to prevent tile shrinkage, expansion, or adhesive degradation.
- Do not use excessive amounts of water during cleaning, and never soak the tiles or subfloor, especially if tiles are installed with adhesives or tackifiers.
- Keep tiles free from oil, grease, and petroleum-based substances, which can permanently damage the surface and backing materials.
- Ensure floor protectors or castor cups are used under furniture to minimise pressure indentations and prevent long-term damage.
- In commercial or public spaces, establish a routine maintenance schedule, including vacuuming frequency, periodic deep cleaning, and inspection intervals based on foot traffic levels.
- Record all maintenance activities to support product warranty claims and to demonstrate adherence to recommended care practices.
